يُبَاعِدُنَا عَنْ مُشَاهَدَتِكَ وَمَحَبَّتِكَ وَآمِنَّا عَلَى السُّنَّةِ وَالْجَمَاعَةِ وَالشُّوقِ إِلَى لِقَائِكَ
يَا ذَا الْجَلَالِ وَالْإِكْرَامِ وَصَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَى سَيِّدِنَا وَمَوْلَانَا مُحَمَّدٍ وَعَلَى آلِهِ وَصَحْبِهِ وَسَلَّمَ
